It has been a changing landscape and challenging period for all of us in recent years, but one thing that remains unchanged is Family Promise of the Coastal Empire's commitment to assisting housing-insecure families in Bryan, Chatham, and Effingham counties. Since I joined the organization eight years ago and was chosen to lead Family Promise as Executive Director when the counties merged in 2020, our region has experienced significant growth and a great lack of affordable housing. Our mission is to not only break the cycle of homelessness among families, but also to lift an entire population out of poverty for good. I am proud of our top-notch programs, training workshops, and initiatives that individuals can work through to improve their circumstances for good – giving them a hand-up and not just a hand-out.

As we commit to reducing the number of families who are separated when they fall on difficult times and find themselves homeless, we ask families in our programs to take advantage of our mentoring, homelessness-prevention programs and services, and initiatives to address the underlying causes of homelessness. Family Promise has a strong track record of keeping families together while offering support and resources toward long-term independence.
